Figure 1: Member designation*

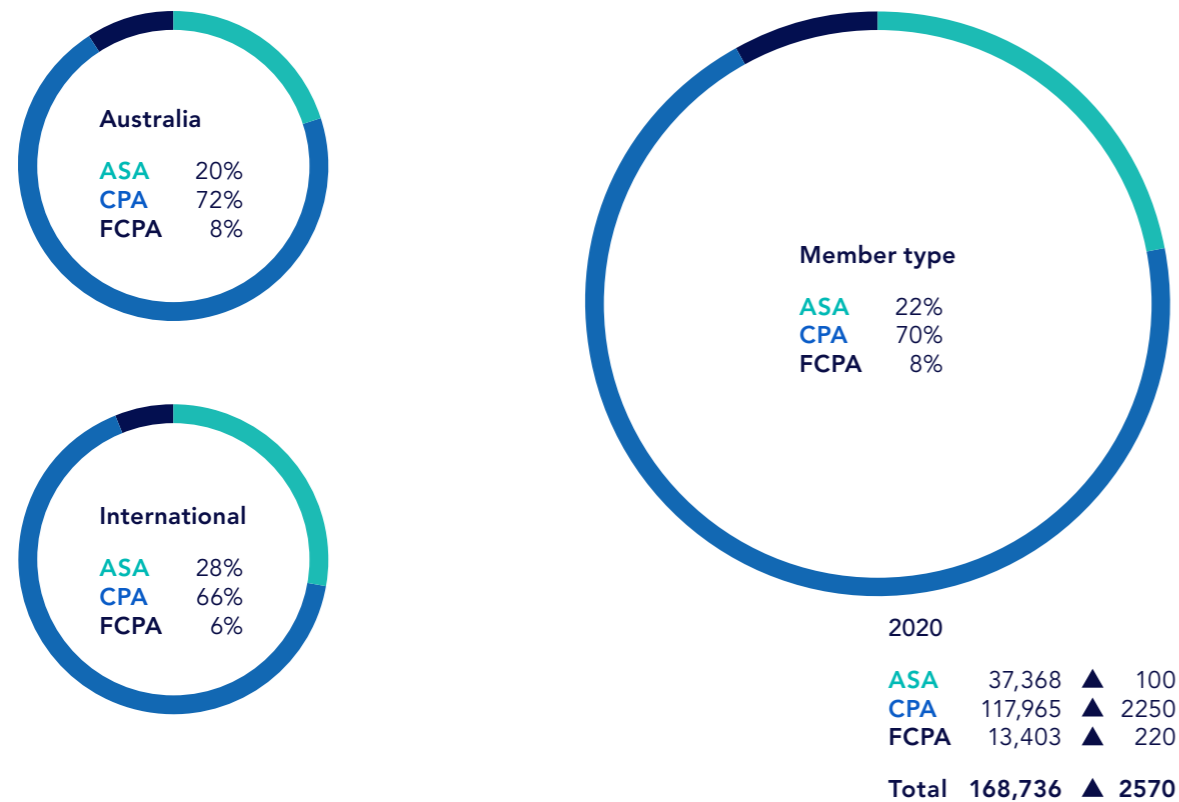
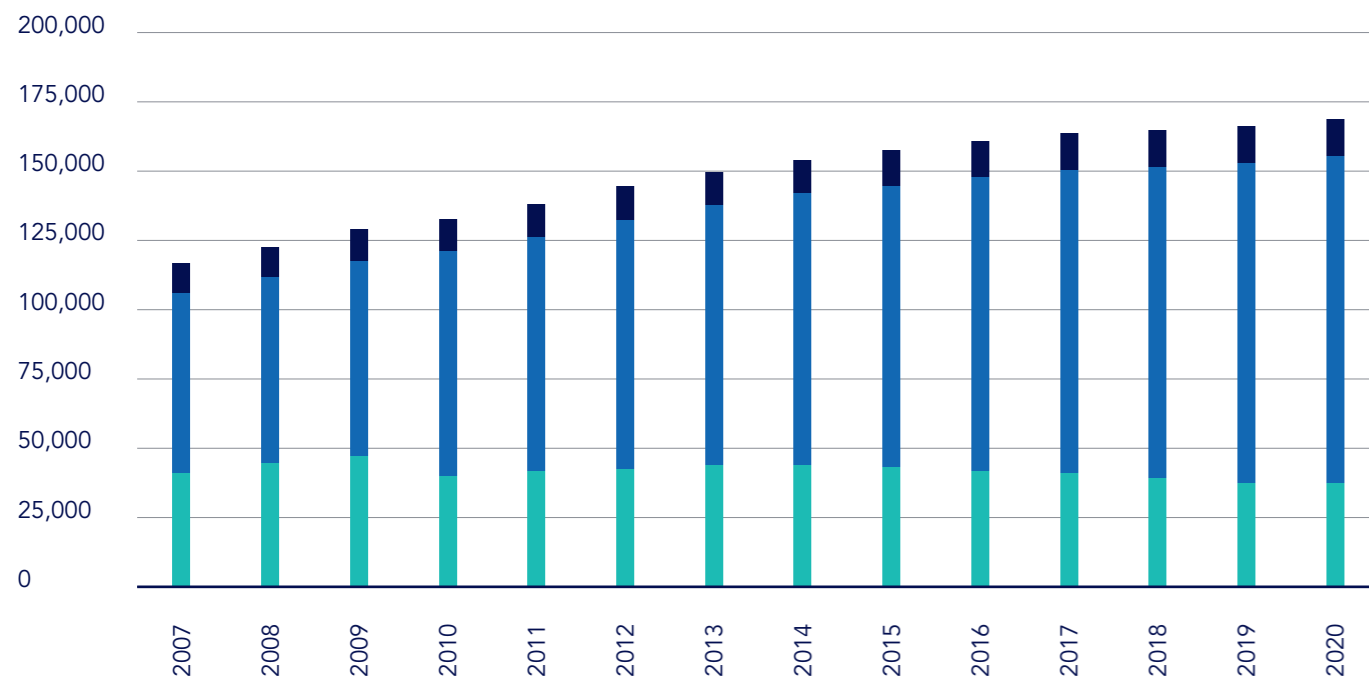


Figure 2: Membership growth

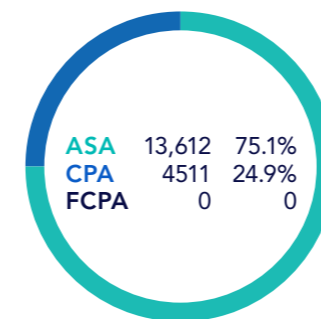

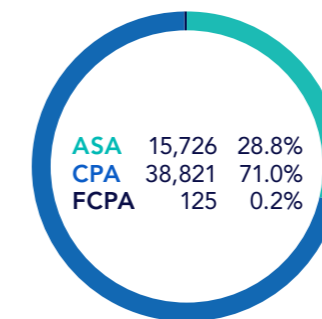

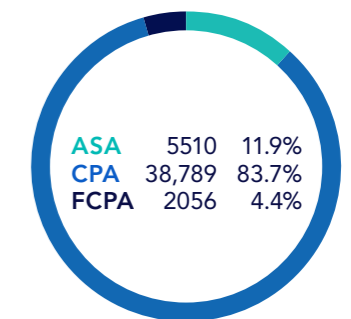

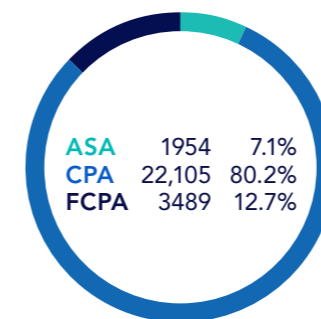

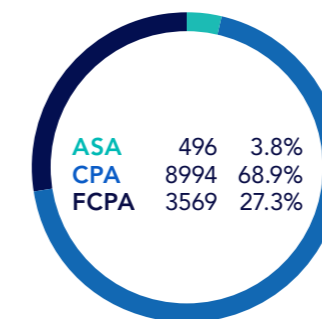

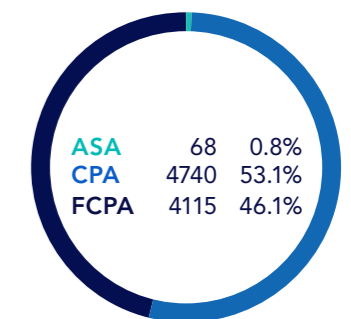
