


#### **BUSINESS CONFIDENCE ON 2016 ECONOMY**



How confident are you about China's economic outlook for 2016?




#### The EXPECATION OF CHINA'S GDP GROWTH IN 2016

In comparison to 2015, do you expect the revenue generated in China by your enterprise for 2016 will ....?





By what percentage do you believe your company's capital expenditure in China in 2016 will change from 2015?




#### CHANGES ON COMPANY HEADCOUNT



#### POSITIVE IMPACTS ON CHINA'S ECONOMY 2016




Which of the following factors do you think will most positively impact on China's economy in 2016?





## INDUSTRIES CONTRIBUTE MOST TO CHINA'S ECONOMIC GROWTH



Which of the following industries do you believe will make the most contribution to China's 2016 economic growth?




#### THE FACTORS CONTRIBUTE TO COMPANY REVENUE



Which of the following factors do you believe will make the largest contribution to revenue growth?






Under the government's support to boost mass entrepreneurship and innovation, which policy do you believe will benefit your company the most?






What impacts do you believe from the China-Australia Free Trade Agreement may bring to your company's business in future? (Multiple options)


